1. What is the worst weather storm you have ever experienced? Talk about some of the extreme weather you have seen.
2. What are some of the storms/trials in your life that Jesus has brought you through and what did you learn through them?

Discussion

1. Read Mark 6:45-56 together as a group. Remembering that the context of this passage is how Jesus works through our storms, what stands out to you?
2. On Sunday, Pastor Matt talked about Jesus always knowing where you are at and praying for you through your hardest of times, just as he was for the disciples in vs 46-48. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus is always looking out for you?
3. Look at Mark 6:50, Matthew 14:27 and John 6:20. What are the three things Jesus says to his disciples and why is it important that we remember them when going through storms?
4. What was Jesus really hoping for his disciples through the miracles of this event?
5. Why do you think it was significant that after Jesus got into the boat and calmed the storm, that he took them to a whole other part of the region than originally planned? Has God ever redirected your path in life?
6. On Sunday, we learned that Jesus is never inconvenienced by us coming to him for help. What do you need to bring to Jesus today? End in a time of sharing and prayer for each other.
